ESG evaluation criteria is included in our investment manager searches as part of the initial due diligence process and most recently we have integrated third-party analytics to provide portfolio-level insight and reporting across a number of ESG factors.

In recent years, the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) have emerged as the leading framework for reporting, servings as the "universal language" when incorporating ESG into the investment process at the asset owner, asset manager, and underlying issuer levels. As such, Marquette has developed customized workshops aimed at educating asset owners on use of the SDGs and aligning a client's investment objective and mission with them. We also incorporate the SDGs as part of our initial manager due diligence process and ongoing evaluation criteria.
